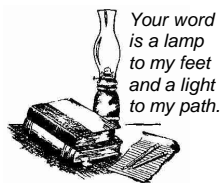

Statement of Christian Education and Agreement

The purpose of Christian Education at MCA is to provide an education that is academically sound and consistent with God's Word. Therefore, a Christian education is concerned with molding the student's character as well as helping him or her gain the knowledge needed to live a Christ-centered life.

1. Parents have the responsibility to train up their child (Deuteronomy 6). The Academy is here to assist and reinforce lessons being taught at home. The lessons in character and learning must also be lived by parents in the home. If there is a persistent problem with a student, his or her parents must be involved to correct it.

2. The standard used for both character development and academic instruction is the Bible. The character of the student will be trained according to the Fruits of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22). The student will be taught to build Biblical principles into his or her life. In addition to the Bible, other educational material will be used. These materials will be reviewed first - to be sure they are consistent with the Bible.

3. The training of students involves both instruction and correction. The correction of the student can range from a verbal reprimand to expulsion. (see Discipline Policy) In all serious cases, the parent(s) will be informed and involved in the process of correction and reconciliation.

4. "By signing this Enrollment Contract, I and my child agree to the rules, regulations, and policies of the School as established in the Parent/Student Handbook, and as interpreted, applied, and enforced by the Principal and the School Board. I also understand that these rules, regulations, and policies are subject to change, from time to time, by the School Board, and that the School reserves the right to amend, supplement, delete or otherwise deviate from these rules, regulations, and policies in the exercise of its educational and management responsibilities. Such changes will be effective and binding when published to the School community.

5. I agree to release and hold harmless the school, its agents and employees from claims, damages, losses, or other liabilities for injuries to the student not from gross or willful negligence by the school, its agents or employees. I agree to indemnify the school for damage caused by my child.

6. I acknowledge and understand that my obligation to pay tuition is semi-annual. This is unconditional as of April 1, 2009. No deduction or remission of tuition shall be made by the school for any absence, dismissal or withdrawal for disciplinary, health, academic, personal or other reasons whatsoever including temporary school closure in the even of a disaster or pandemic.

7. I acknowledge and understand that the school may withhold grades or transcripts, or not permit my child to take examinations or be admitted to a succeeding term until outstanding accounts, including tuition and other charges, have been paid in full. As permitted by law, I will be obligated to pay the school's expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs, to collect tuition and other charges not paid timely.

My signature affirms I am a Parent or Guardian financially responsible for the student listed. I, the undersigned, agree that I have read, understand and accept the terms and conditions outlined in the Parent Student Handbook. I further acknowledge that I will uphold my financial and my 40 hours of volunteer responsibilities.
