- ◆ How do you intend to use the knowledge and skills you have gained?
- ◆ What have you discovered about your own thinking?
- ◆ What new ways have you discovered to view yourself?
- ◆ What have you learned about yourself in this process?
- ◆ How has your active research been applied?
- ◆ What have you learned of God and His ways?
